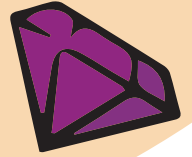


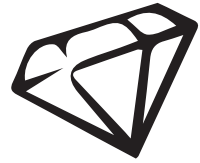
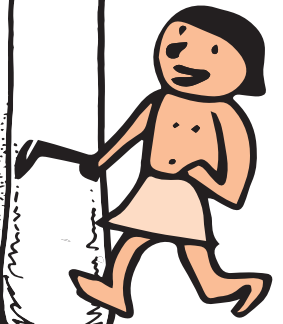
Let's take a journey to Ancient Egypt

Wadi el-Hudi lies in the south of Egypt, a country in Africa.

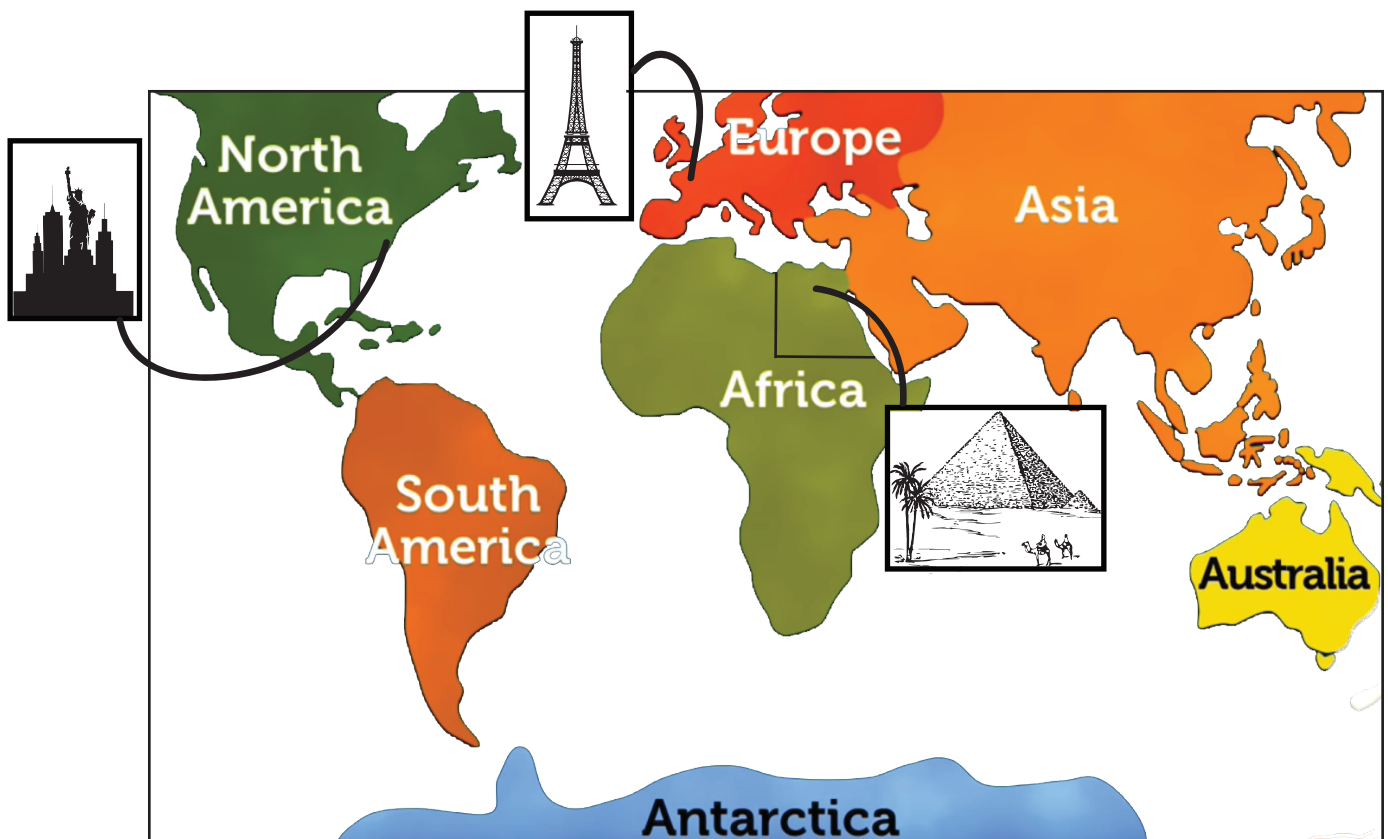

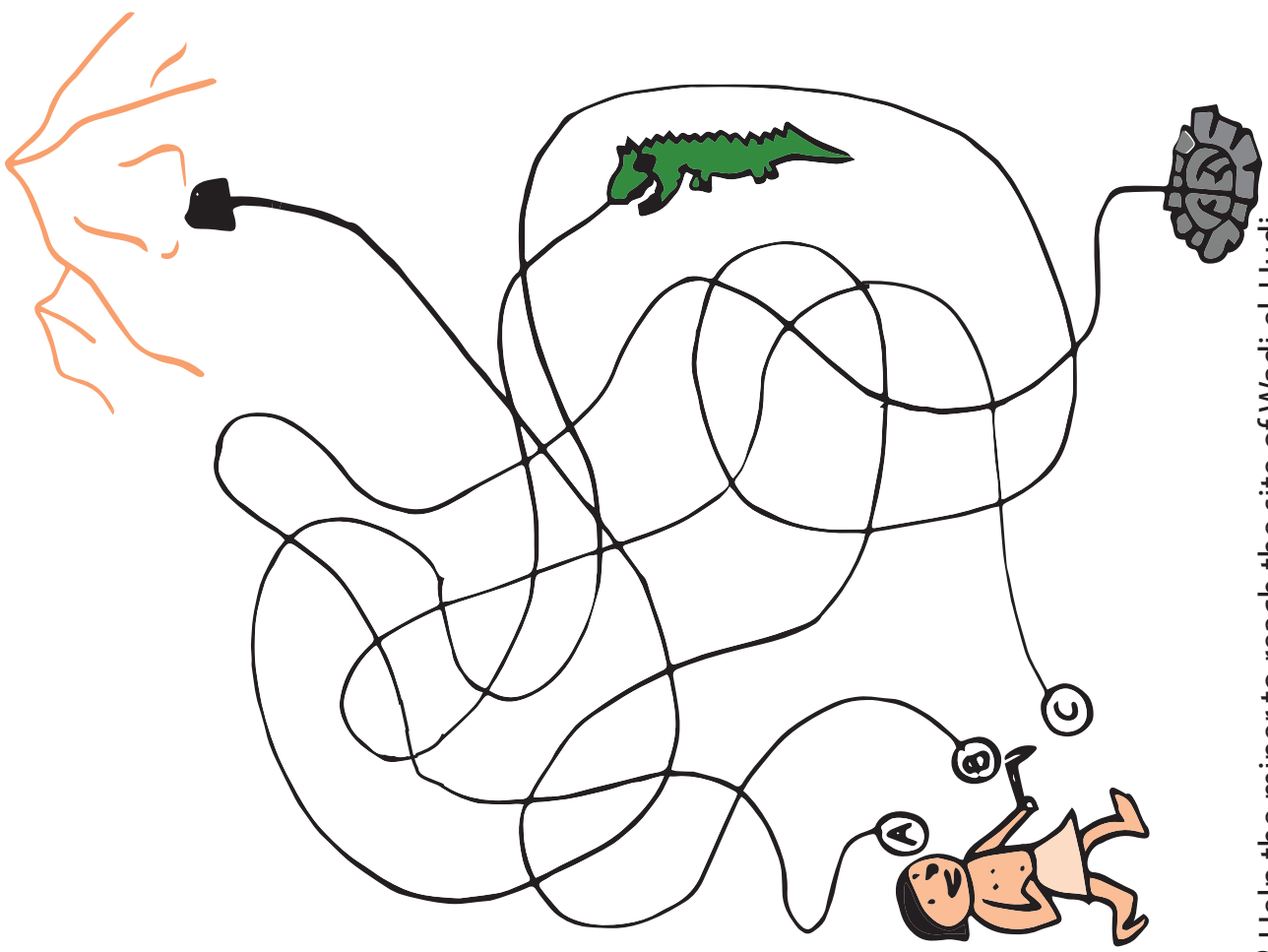
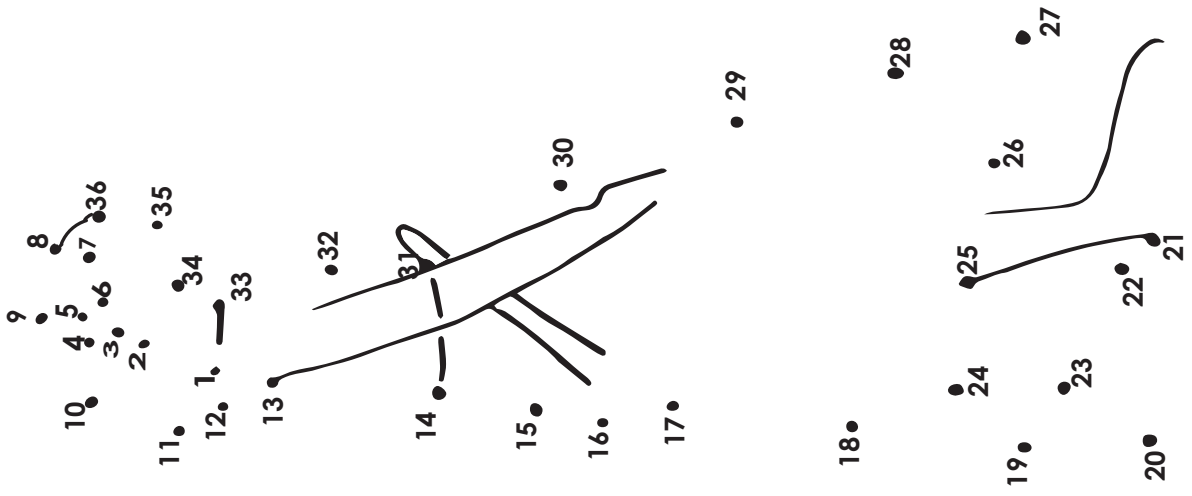
Before we begin...

Can you find where the Ancient Egyptians lived?



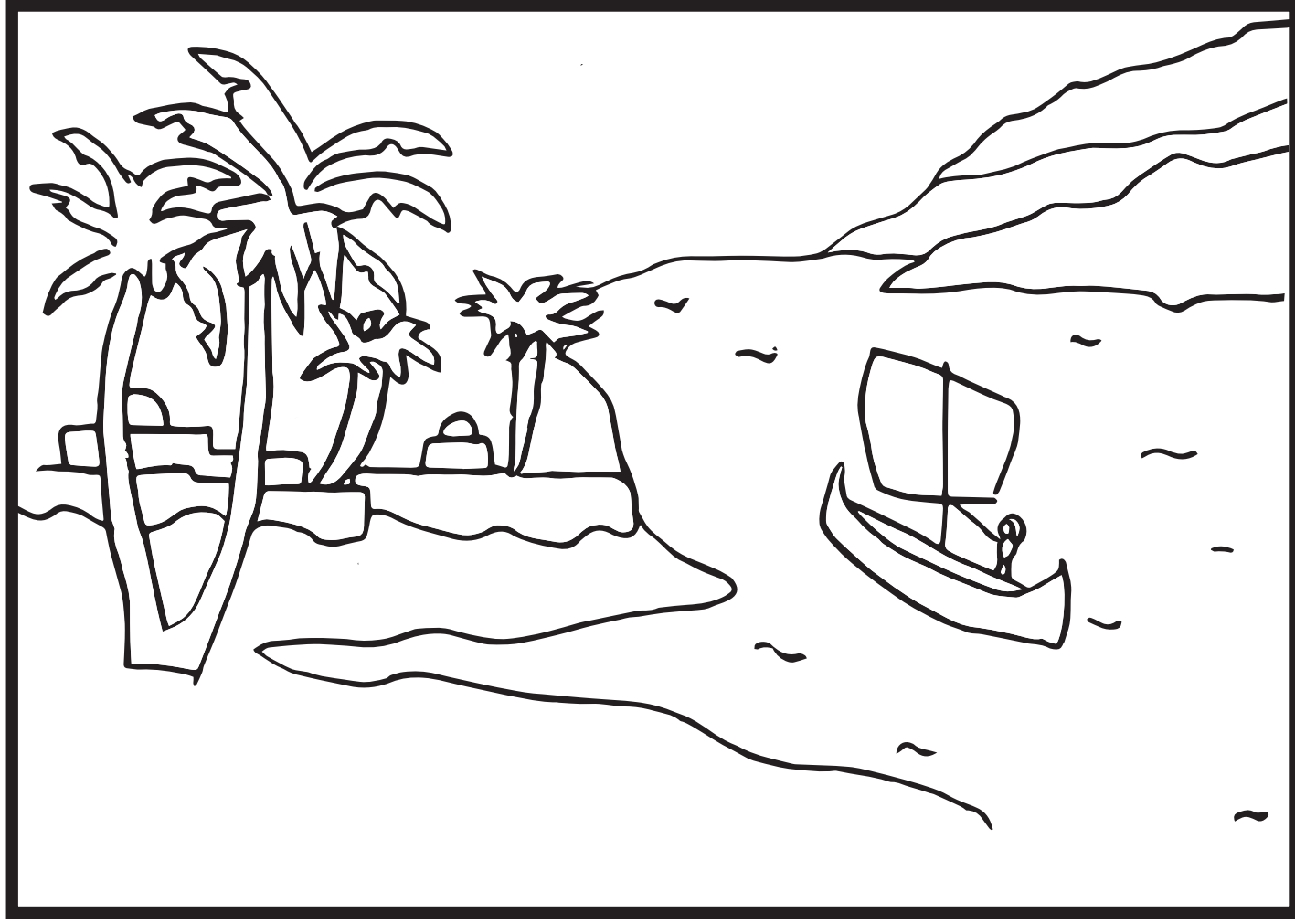
1 A stele was found on the archaeological site of Wadi el-Hudi. Connect the points from 1 to 36 to find out what it represents!



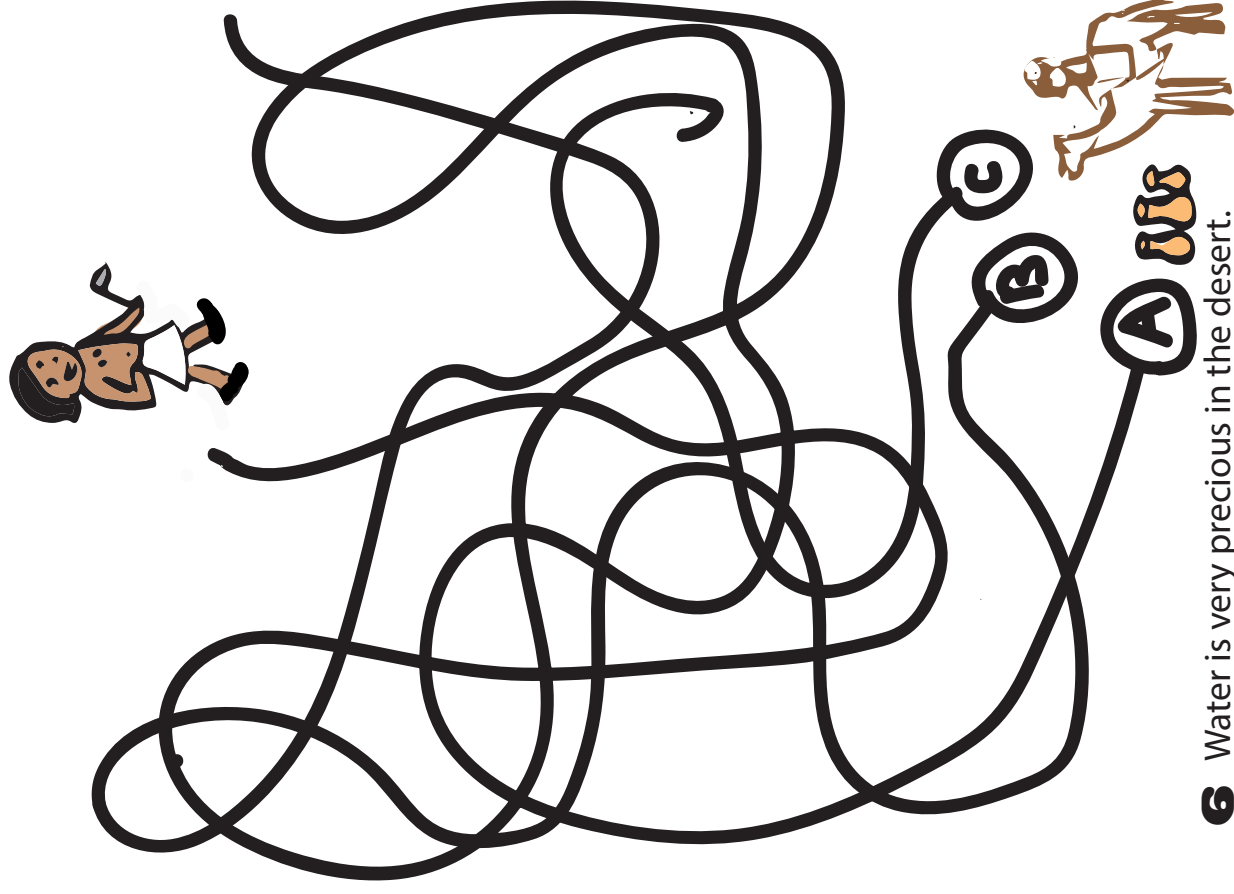
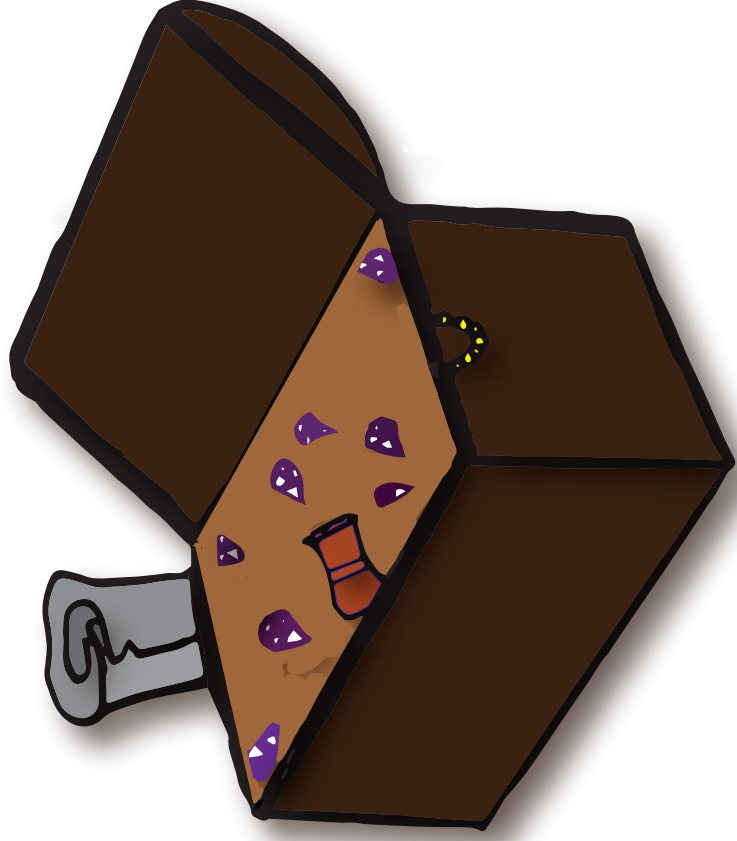
2 Help the miner to reach the site of Wadi el-Hudi.

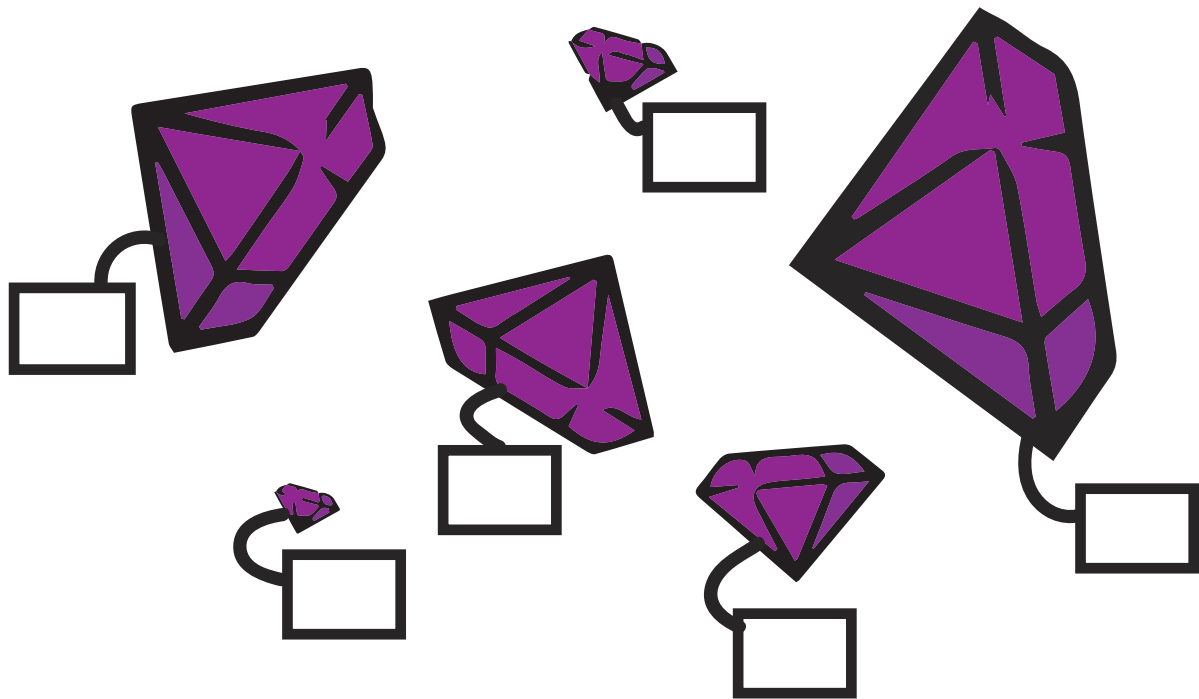


- 5** Several amethysts (purple stones) are in the treasure chest. How many are there?

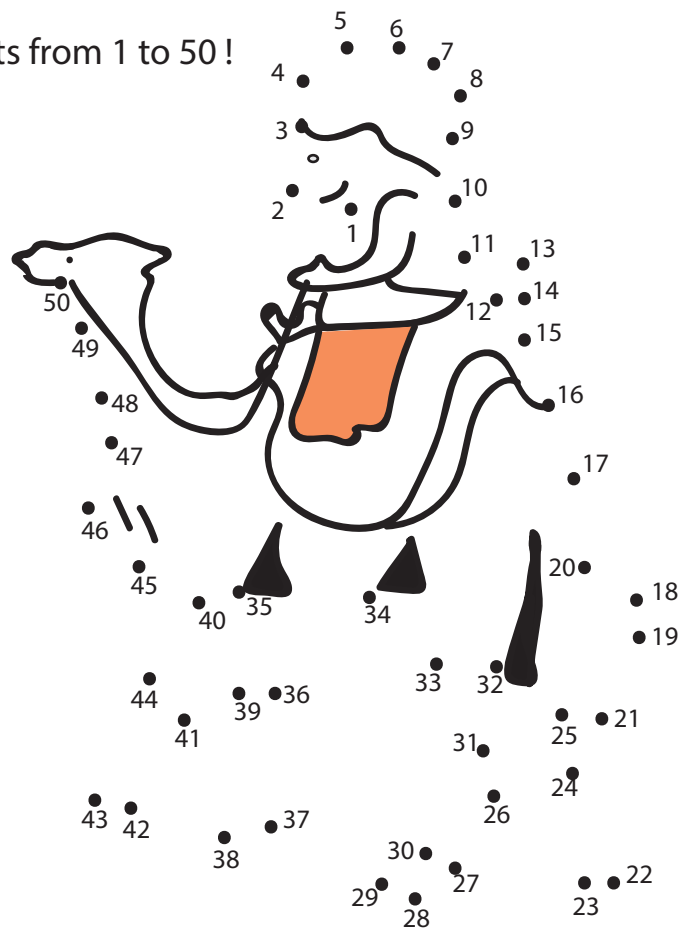


- 6** Water is very precious in the desert. Which way must Seti and his camel take to give water to the miner?

- 7** Number from 1 to 6 the amethysts coming from Wadi El-Hudi, from the smallest to the largest.



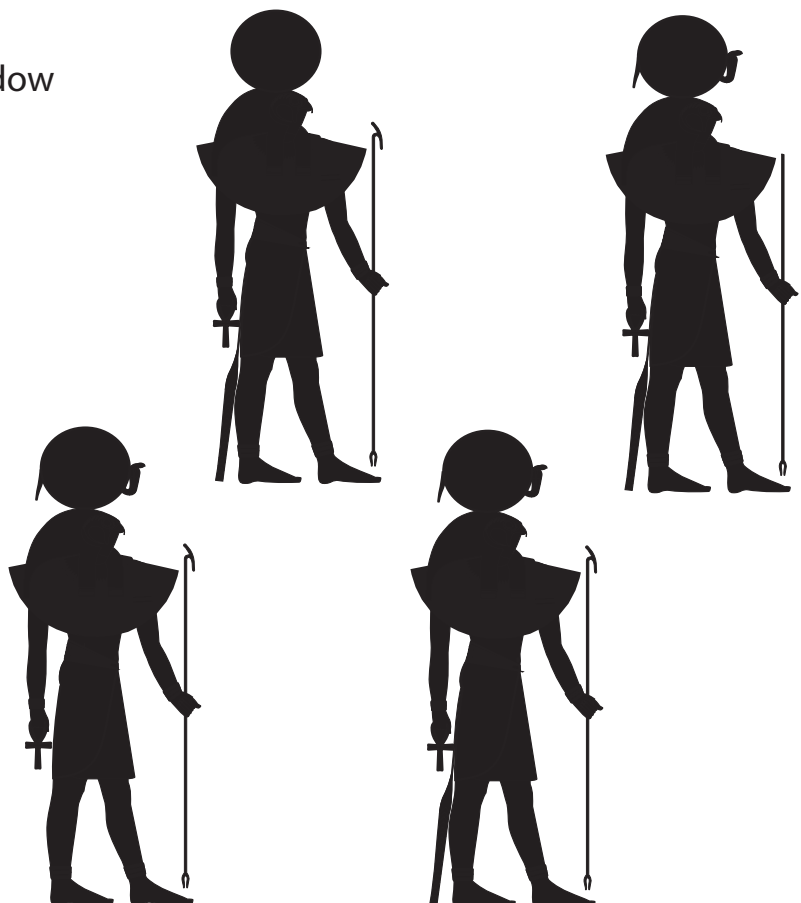
- 8** Connect the dots from 1 to 50!

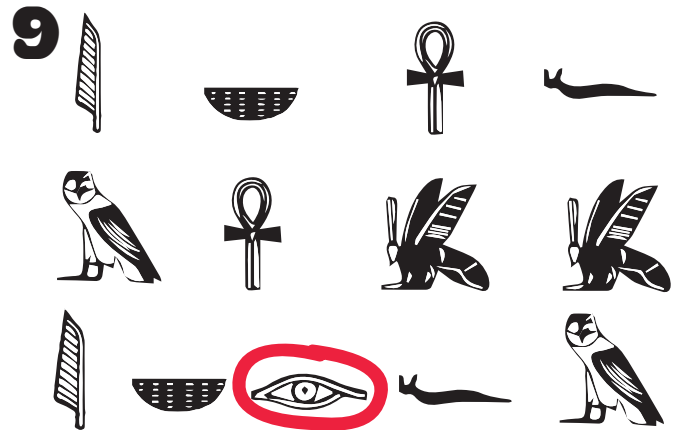
- 10** Find the correct shadow of the sun god Ra.

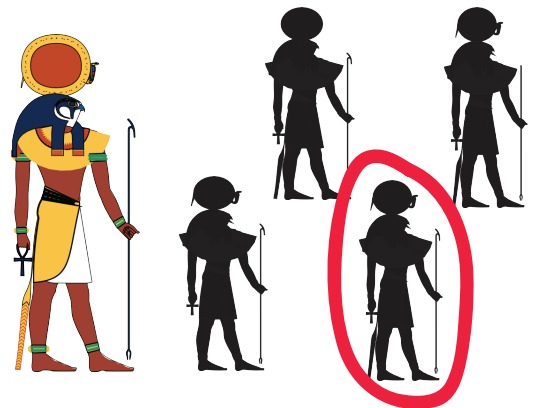
