

## Wadi el-Hudi Word Search Meanings



**Wadi el Hudi**: a site in ancient Egypt near Aswan which is known for the amethyst mining that took place here

Pottery: containers, bowls, cups, and jars made out of fired clay

**Nubia**: a civilization that neighbored Ancient Egypt from the south

**Egypt**: a civilization spanning thousands of years that became famous for its pyramids, mummification

process, pharaohs, gods, hieroglyphics and more.

Stela: a stone slab with hieroglyphs etched on it

Inscription: these are series of hieroglyphs on the stela

Amethyst: a purple mineral heavily mined at Wadi el Hudi

Mine: an area with large amount of minerals material that can be dug from the ground

Jewelry: necklaces, rings, bracelets, earrings made from the precious minerals mined

Archaeology: scientific excavation and study of ancient humans and their material remains

Gold: a yellow, precious material mined in Egypt

Desert: a vast, dry, sandy that surrounds the Nile River

Pharaoh: the ruler of Upper and Lower Egypt

Hieroglyphs: ancient writing system of the Egyptians

**Zir**: type of pottery container that stored water

Miners: workers who would mine for different minerals like gold, copper, amethyst

Egyptologist: an archaeologist that focuses their study and research on Egypt

Rock Crystal: this type of quartz mineral is connected to amethyst but is clear instead of purple
